VGP - German expert Michael Waibel made public a book of pographs on Ha Noi titled "Ha Noi – Capital city" on March 6.






Visitors sense it as well, the marked contrast to other Southeast Asian cities with their freeways and concrete jungles, marvelling at Ha Noi's many squares and small parks, the tree-lined avenues with their leafy canopies, the bustling neighbourhoods and the endless stream of motorbikes. Ha Noi's growth and economic development is at a crossroads, though.

Michael Waibel is a senior researcher and project leader in urbanism at the Department for Geography of the University of Hamburg. He made public a book of photographs on Ha Noi titled "Ha Noi - Capital city".

The book in three languages, including German, Vietnamese and English, is about the history and urban development of Ha Noi City. It consists of more than 600 photos on many topics, including Hanoi from above, change over time, Ha Noi heritage, housing, waterways, the people of Hanoi, urban

transport, Ha Noi villages, cultural life, and the soul of Ha Noi.
